Please note that CLCOW shows are not NCHA approved though we do follow the NCHA rules.

In addition to our shows, a good time was had by all at the Jackpot sponsored by Gayle Wilkinson on May 20th. It was a great addition to the CLCOW summer schedule and successful for the Club. Hopefully there will be more to follow.
